603 CMR 28.04 (5)(c) ... The district shall consider family size and family income information in relation to Federal Poverty Guidelines and shall contribute public funds to the costs of the independent education evaluation according to the following standards:

- a. If the family income is <u>equal to or less than 400% of the federal poverty guidelines</u>, the <u>district shall pay 100%</u> of the costs of an independent education evaluation.
- b. If the family income is <u>between 400% and 500% of the federal poverty guidelines</u>, the <u>district</u> <u>shall pay 75%</u> of the costs of an independent education evaluation.
- c. If the family income is between <u>500% and 600% of the federal poverty guidelines</u>, the <u>district</u> <u>shall pay 50%</u> of the costs of an independent education evaluation
- d. If the family income is <u>over 600% of the federal poverty guidelines</u>, the district shall have <u>no</u> <u>obligation to cost-share with the parent</u>.
