### ASE MULTIPLE MEMBER BENEFIT DISCOUNT

The Multiple Member Benefit Discount Opportunity **closes October 12, 2021 Conference.** <u>This discount opportunity</u> <u>allows for additional professionals from your district, school or agency who becomes a 2021-2022 ASE Voting or Active</u> <u>Member and registers for all three ASE Conferences to receive a discount</u>.

For additional professionals from your district to be eligible for the discount, your district must have at least one 2021-2022 ASE Voting or Active Membership along with the selection of all three conferences at a total of \$800.

The Multiple Member Benefit Discount Opportunity rate for additional Voting and Active Memberships, along with the registration for all three ASE Conferences <u>will be reduced from \$800 to \$706.50</u>.
