SPEDEX: SPECIAL EDUCATION EXPERT PILOT PROJECT Resolving special education disputes through a child-centered approach.

The Special Education Day Committee (SPEDCO), the Bureau of Special Education Appeals (BSEA) of the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE), and the SpedEx Planning Committee are pleased to announce the launch of the pilot SpedEx Project. This Project grew out of annual Special Education Day celebrations, attended by educators, DESE officials, parents, and other interested parties.

Brief overview of SpedEx:

Special education delivery is often hampered by litigious disputes between families, experts, and school districts. SpedEx focuses on removing the anxiety, anger, and expense of litigation through a research-based, dispute resolution approach that targets what the child needs. Key features:

- Use of independent, neutral educational experts (SpedEx Experts) jointly selected by families and schools who voluntarily choose the SpedEx option
- Use of student information and research by SpedEx Experts to assess and/or recommend individualized FAPE-driven placements
- Appropriate placement of students by agreement within 30 days
- Post-placement observation and review by SpedEx Expert
- Decisions made through joint school-family approach, with knowledge, willingness, and cooperation

We now seek participants for this innovative SpedEx Project by:

- Potential SpedEx Experts, to be pre-qualified as vendors
- An Administrator for the BSEA's SpedEx Project
